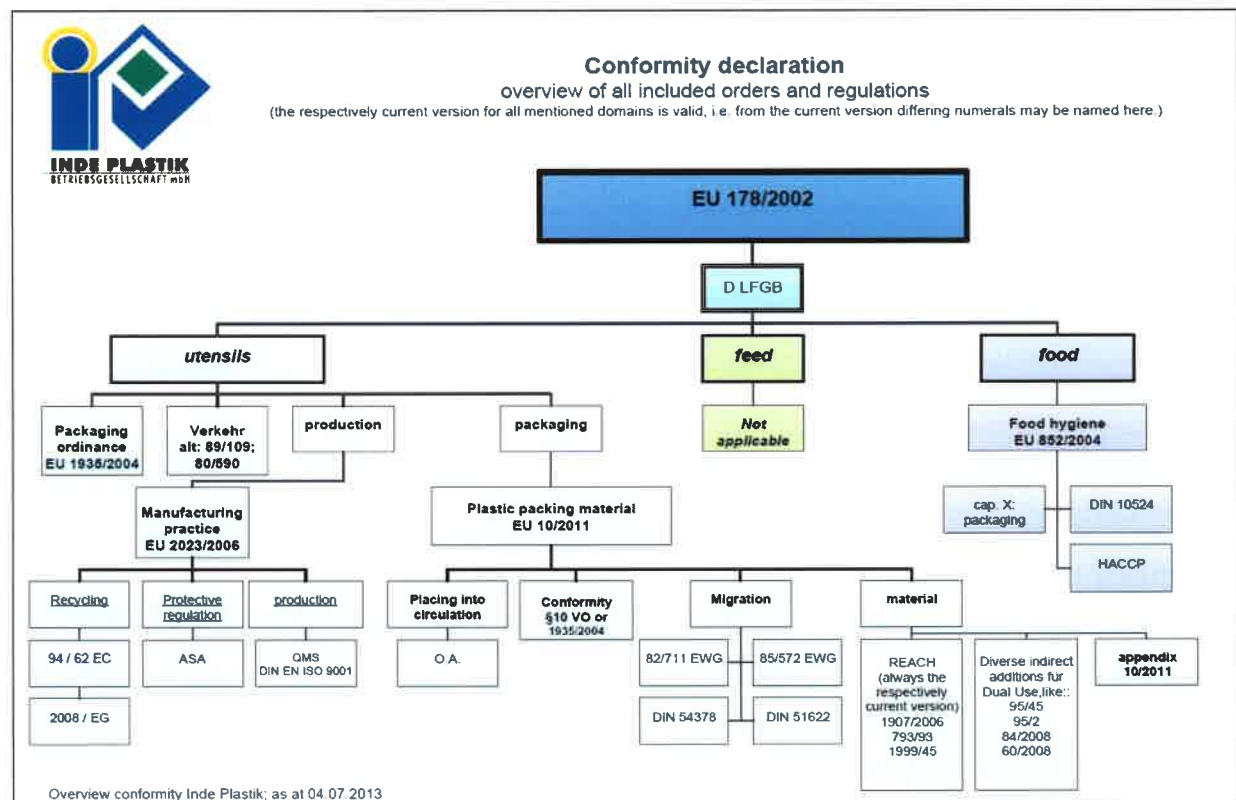


Conformity Declaration

(Detailed information of conformity declaration in acc. w. EU 10/2011 Appendix IV, Page L12/81)

Inde Plastik confirms that our products comply with the valid food laws EU 178/2002 [D LFGB] and the regulations derived from this contained in Consumer Goods Ordinance EU 1935/2004 [D Packaging Ordinance] and the food hygiene in accordance with EU 852/2004, each in the current valid version.

Inde Plastik uses a certified HACCP system in the context of implementation of food hygiene. The EU ordinance for plastic packaging EU 10/2011 in addition to the ordinance for manufacturing practice EU 2023/2006 in the current valid versions apply to implementation of packaging ordinance EU 1935/2004.

The items in question are foods packaging made of **extruded foamed polystyrene, with and without laminate (EPS)**.

The materials used conform to Ordinance 10/2011 in the current valid version.

Information on the materials used (different proportions depending on the product):

- Polystyrene : ca. 99%
- Nucleating agent: 0, 2 to max. 1%
- Colour: 0, 0 to max. 1%
- Laminate: 0, 0 to max. 1% (comp. clause 8)
- Butane gas: 3, 0 – 4, 0 weight.-% based on the above raw material charge

The product does not contain any functional barriers. All safety datasheets and declarations of harmlessness are available to Inde Plastik.

Information on the limitations of product usage:

- i) The articles are suitable for all foods
- ii) The products are not suitable for use in microwaves, conventional ovens, infrared or multi-purpose ovens.
- iii) The products are heat resistant up to max. 90°C (see label)
- iv) Below 0°C the product may become brittle and mechanically break under load.
- v) There is no limitation for the storage duration.
- vi) Restrictions for the use of the packaging itself due to substances contained are not applicable. The overall migration and the specific migration values are below the statutory limit values if used in accordance with specification. Inspections for this purpose were carried out in accordance with the regulations contained in 82/711 EEC and 85/572 EEC (The conversion is 1 kg food / 6 dm²).
